#### Theme: Welcome to Pre-K

Our theme is Welcome to Pre-K. This month we will focus on "What will I learn and do in Pre-K?", "What do I bring to my classroom community?", and "Who are the people in my classroom community?" We will explore our classroom and become comfortable in our new surroundings. The children will identify and discuss different emotions they may be experiencing in their new environment. 
As we read this month we will focus on the Skill: **Character**. The children will identify who the character is as they read. The children will make a connection to the characters and think about what they would do if they were that character.

<u>Writing</u>: Children will use a combination of drawing, dictating or writing to narrate a story about themselves. Children will put characters(them) in their story and label "me". They will read and retell what they wrote about.
